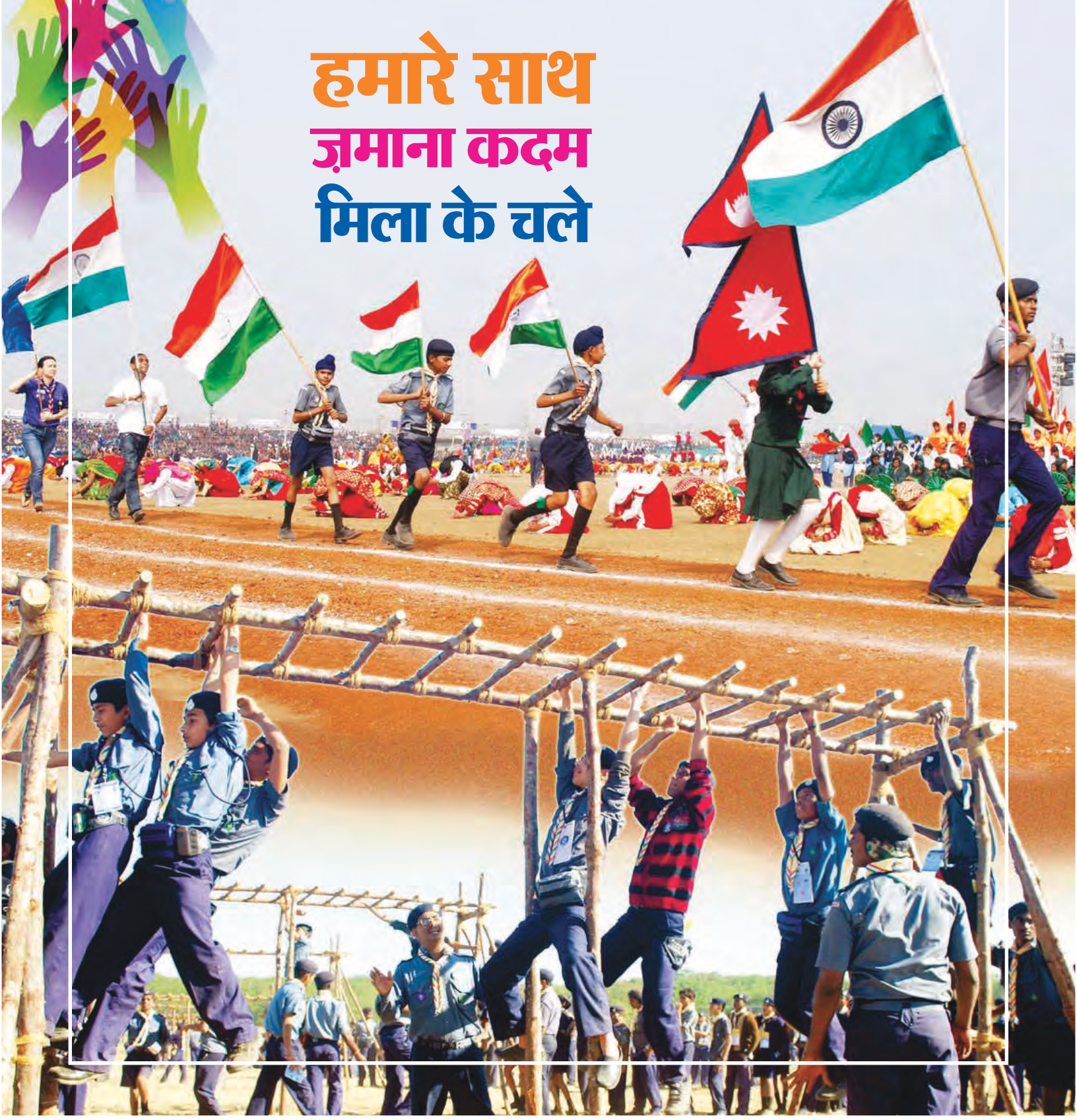

Need of the hour!

Swami Vivekananda was known not just as a man who launched a revolution that even to this day resonates around the world, but a soul that enlightened the minds and conscious of many.

He was the first Indian to represent his country and Hinduism at the gigantic platform- Parliament of the World's Religions in the year 1893. There is an interesting tale behind this.

Vivekananda came to know that for the first time a Parliament of World's Religions was being organized in Chicago, where delegates from all over the world were invited to join in.

On his arrival in Chicago on July 30, 1893, Vivekananda learned that no one without any credential or bona fide could attend the Parliament as a delegate. Though he felt, utterly disappointed, but he didn't give up.

As the event was weeks away, and Chicago seemed to be bit expensive for him, Vivekananda decided to cut down on his expenditure and to start with, he moved to Boston.

There he met Professor John Henry Wright of Harvard University, who requested him to give a lecture at the University; and, later helped him get the requisite credentials for the big event.

Impressed by his friend's generosity, Swami Vivekananda decided to open up to people of Boston and Chicago.

During his stay for next few days in Boston, Swami Vivekananda came across so many people, some of whom inspired him and some who he left inspired.

Just a day before the big event, Swami Vivekananda returned to Chicago. In the evening, he decided to spend some time with himself, to clear his mind ahead of his lecture the next day.

For the evening walk, Vivekananda remained in his saffron robe, and while he was walking near a park, a woman (who had been conspicuously observing him for sometime) stopped him.

Unable to control her thoughts, she asked him, "Can't you wear proper clothes to look like a gentleman?"

Vivekananda with a polite smile and gesture replied, "In your culture, a tailor makes a gentleman; but, in our culture, Character makes the gentleman."

The same had been realized as the objective of Scouting by our Founder and all our activities are centered round

the CHARACTER of an individual member of our movement. `Personality is who we are and what we do when everybody is watching. But Character is who we are and what we do when nobody is watching.`

We cannot locate character directly. But our expression, by way of thought or speech or deeds betrays our character. Any such expression invariably exposes a bit of the totality of our true inner personality. And the totality of our true inner personality is our character. The 9th part of Scout/Guide law states the same.

Character is a bundle of habits. Habits form through repeated actions. Actions come through thought or speech and thoughts come from ideas. Ideas are shaped in our mind. A number of ideas, both good and bad will be formed. But we should be very careful while selecting our ideas. To get good ideas one should have determination to read good books or listen to worthy speeches of elders like Swami Vivekananda or associate with people in a good organization and interact with them. `We are what our thoughts have made us;

so take care about what you think. Words are secondary. Thoughts live and they travel far,` said Vivekananda.

If a man continuously hears good, thinks good thoughts, and does good works, the sum total of these impressions will be good; and in a similar manner, will force him to do good and he develops good character. If a man continuously hears bad things, thinks bad thoughts and does bad works, the sum total of these impressions will be bad and the man develops a bad character.

As the Founder repeatedly said, a scout master`s job is not that of a teacher because the scout master is well concerned about the all round development of the boy which is beyond the scope of a class room teacher. In this context, Swami Vivekananda`s advice to students is worthy to mention: ` Education is not the amount of information that is put into your brain. We want that education by which character is formed, strength of mind is increased, the intellect is expanded, and by which one can stand on one`s own feet.` His advice reflects in the purpose which is one of the four fundamentals of The Bharat Scouts and Guides.

It is the need of the hour that the adults in scouting motivate boys and girls and even the youth in their areas to join the movement for building a strong nation.

Korea Scout Association (KSA) and the World Scout Bureau Asia-Pacific Region (APR) have signed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Korea's ecological capital, Suncheon city on 16 December 2008 to manage the Suncheon Asia-Pacific Scout Centre (SAPSC) where young people may improve their global leadership potentials. From the beginning of March 2009, the SAPSC had offered programs in English based on the Scout method of "learning by doing" - a hands-on experiential learning process in the outdoors through young leaders from the National Scout Organizations. Korean youth may learn real-life, everyday spoken English and global leadership through various outdoor hands-on programs, weekly English camp programs, and seasonal experiential programs. At the same time, staff members learn about Korea's rich history, culture, and tradition and share the brotherhood of Scouting with participants and visitors.

SAPSC is an international scout centre where scouts from different countries all over the world come to volunteer as teachers. The scout volunteers teach about their culture and in return they learn about Korean culture.

This Year 2017, I got the opportunity to represent my country India in the said three months World Culture English Programme in South Korea. We were 6 Volunteers from different parts of the World, I reached Sancheon Asia Pacific Scout Centre (SAPSC), on 21st August 2017 and was there till 14th November 2017. Our programme officially started on 29th August 2017. The programme was based on the Scout method of learning/teaching. Everyday students of various schools of Sancheon City visited the centre and learned various cultures & different Scout Skills. It was an honour for me to work with other volunteers at SAPSC for three months and



also to take active part in the different Scout Programmes of Korea Scout Association. During the stay in South Korea, I got the opportunity to interact with various key/high officials of KSA to explore various places of South Korea. One of the interesting programme was temple stay. Sancheon Asia Pacific Scout Centre is the centre for youth where they can enhance their skills and learn more. I got the opportunity to visit the 2023 World Scout Jamboree Place which is going to be hosted by Korea Scout Association at Samagagum. On 23rd September 2017 I was conferred with "International friendship Award" by the Korea Scout Association.

I am thankful to all who supported me to be at SAPSC, South Korea for three months, especially The Bharat Scouts and Guides National Headquarters, J&K State Bharat Scouts and Guides and the Korea Scout Association.

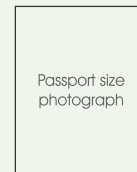

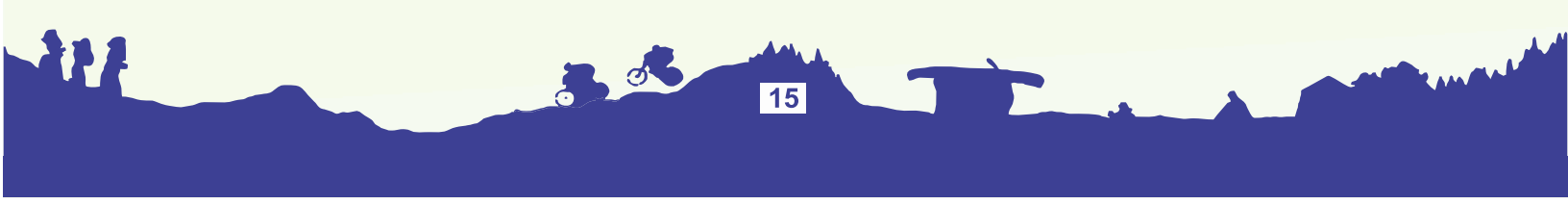
