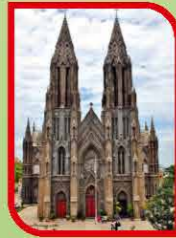

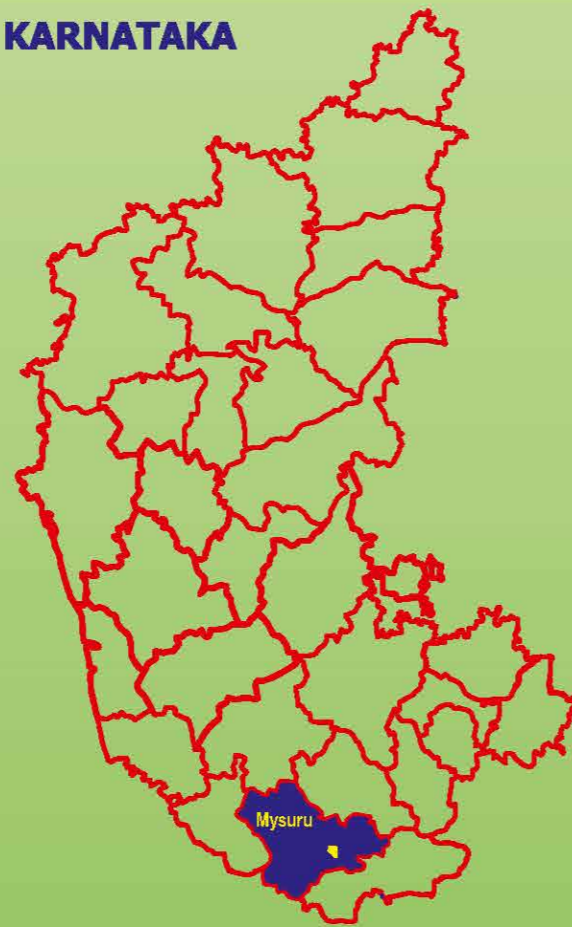

Reach Mysuru Railway Station/Bus Stand

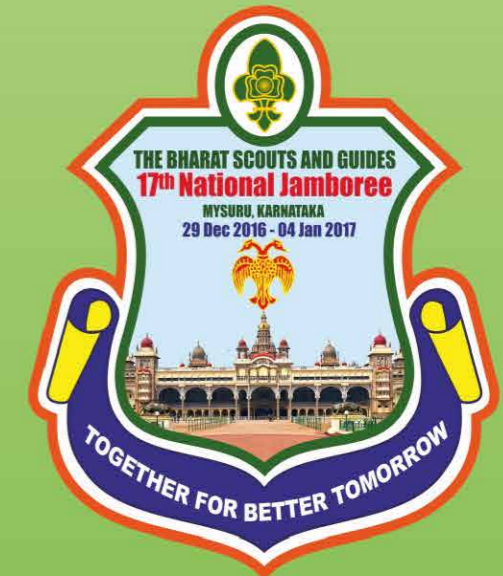
1. The Jamboree Site is 17 kms away from the Mysuru City and 159 Kms from Bengaluru City Railway Station.

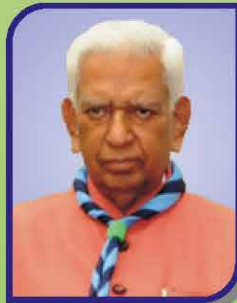

Welcome to Karnataka:

Karnataka is a land of magnificent monuments, breathtaking hill stations, thundering Waterfalls, Wildlife Sanctuaries, Coffee Plantations, Adventure activities, Hub for IT, Cradle for Entrepreneurs and Colourful art forms and festivals. The 7th largest state in the country covers an area of 191,976 square kilometers. It has Maharashtra to the North, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana to its East, Tamil Nadu and Kerala to its South, flanked by Arabian sea and Goa to West and there are about 64.06 million inhabitants.

Bengaluru is the capital city of the Karnataka and the official language of Karnataka is KANNADA. The state has made its mark in all the fields and is the home for many great scholars and stalwarts. Institutions like the Indian Institute of Science, IIM, ISRO, CFTRI, Infosys, Wipro are our pride.

Mysuru :

Mysuru, princely state of Karnataka where the Kingdom was ruled by the Wodeyar dynasty for over 6 centuries. It is the third most populous in the state of Karnataka, located at the base of the Chamundi Hills. It is spread across an area of 128.42 square kilometers and average population is over 30 lakhs.

Mysuru is noted for the oldest Church and the Palaces. The Mysuru Palace, during the Dasara festival receives large number of tourists. It lends its name to the Mysuru style of painting, the Sweet dish Mysurupak, the Mysuru Peta (A traditional Silk Turban) and the garment known as MYSURU SILKSAREE.

Tourism is the major Industry. While Information Technology has emerged as a major employer alongside the traditional Industries. Mysuru depends on Rail and Bus Transport for inter city connections.

Patrons of Art and Culture, the Wodeyars contributed significantly to the cultural growth of the City. Mysuru is known as cultural capital of Karnataka, also as Heritage City for its ambience and traditions. It is certainly a matter of pride that the Maharaja of Mysuru was a member of the Scout Movement and the prince Jayachamaraja Wodeyar was the First Cub. They were instrumental in promoting the Scout Movement in the State.

Climate of Mysuru:

In the Month of December and January, the climate is very pleasant and this is one of the best time of the year to visit Mysuru. The average temperature dipping in the evenings.
