Who can attend	: Rovers and Adult Leaders (Male) between 15-45 Years of age having sound health may be selected according to the quota allotted to the State. Preference may be given those who are experts in Disaster Management, Swimming, First-Aid, Pioneering Project etc. Each candidate has to submit Physical Fitness Certificate from the appropriate authority. Physically unfit candidates should not be selected.
	Note: Without Medical Fitness Certificate, Risk Certificate and deputation letter of the State, Participants will not be admitted in the Camp.
Financial Assistance	: Travelling Expenses are to be borne by the individual participant or its sponsoring authority. We invite our Rovers and Adult Leaders who are dedicated to render their Services Voluntarily.
What to Bring	: Following materials are to be carried by each participant: Two sets of correct and complete uniform as per APRO Part II & III, Track suit, Light Bedding, Personal dress, Sleeping Bag, Ruck- sack, Sleeping mat, Toilet requisites, Torch, Water Bottle, Rope, Plate, Mug, Spoon, Personal First Aid kit, Comfortable Sports Shoe, Lunch Box, P- Cap, Note-Book, Pen etc.
Risk Certificate	: Each candidate has to submit a Risk Certificate (Enclosed) duly signed by the parents and attested by the District Commissioner.

Quota	•	Enclosed. (Quota allocation is for all the 04 Service Camps. States are requested to depute participants equally in all the Camps). Prior confirmation with list of participants in each camp to SHQ Madhya Pradesh is a must with a copy to NHQ.
