### SUB.: APR WORKSHOP ON REVISITING THE SCOUT METHOD.

We are pleased to inform you that the Asia Pacific Region (APR) Plan (2015-2018) adopted at the 25<sup>th</sup> APR Scout Conference in 2015, has included to organize an **"APR Workshop on revisiting the application of the Scout Method"** to achieve Objective on Young People Strategic Priority, which is to encourage National Scout Organizations to re-emphasize in their Youth Programme the implementation of the World Scout Youth Programme Policy, taking into consideration the outcomes of the 1<sup>st</sup> World Scout Education Congress and 40<sup>th</sup> World Scout Conference Resolution.

Therefore, to achieve this strategic priority, the Asia Pacific Regional Support Centre in collaboration the General Association of the Scouts of China will organize the **"APR Workshop on revisiting the Scout Method in August 2016"**. This is also intended to contribute to achieve the targets under "Innovating Scouting" of the WOSM's global Triennial Plan 2014-2017, which read as "to revisit the Scout Method to accurately reflect 21<sup>st</sup> century developments and the World Scout Youth Programme Policy."

#### Details as follows:

Name of the Event	:	APR Workshop on Revisiting the Scout Method.
Dates	:	12 <sup>th</sup> to 15 <sup>th</sup> August, 2016 (Four full days, inclusive of a half-day tour and not including arrival and departure. Participants are expected to arrive at the workshop venue on 11 <sup>th</sup> August, 2016 and may leave on 16 <sup>th</sup> August, 2016. Please plan to arrive at Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport (TPE).
Venue	:	Tamkang University, located at Yingzhuan Road, Tamsui District, in New Taipei City, Taiwan (R.O.C.).
Date of Arrival	:	11 <sup>th</sup> August 2016
Date of Departure	:	16 <sup>th</sup> August 2016
Eligible Participants	:	The primary target of this workshop are Commissioners of any level in NSO or full time executives responsible or in charge of Youth Programme. Other key National Scout leaders, who could be valuable contributors to the workshop, are also welcomed. However, please note that participants must be endorsed by their National Scout Organization.
Aim of the Workshop	:	To gather key leaders from National Scout Organisations and re-visit the application of the Scout Method and share among them ideas on how to effective implement the Scout Method.




<b>Workshop objectives</b>	: At the end of the workshop, the participants will be able to:  <b><u>LEARN</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Analyse the current situation of the Scout Method's philosophy.</li> </ul> <b><u>FEEL</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Accept the effectiveness of the Scout Method, as shared by other participants who have implemented it as the grass-roots level.</li> </ul> <b><u>DO</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Discuss the proposed concept on the Scout Method, coming out of the global review process and enumerate actions on how the Scout Method can effectively be experienced at grassroots level.</li> </ul>
<b>Workshop Fee</b>	: Participation fee is US\$ 150.00, which should include inland transportation between the international airport and the workshop venue, food and accommodation for five days and workshop documents/kit, and half-day educational tour.
<b>Working Language</b>	: The working language of the Workshop is English. State Associations are requested to select participants who are able to understand and take an active part in discussions in English.
<b>Air-fare and Visa charges</b>	: New Delhi ⇌ Taiwan Taouan (TPE) – INR. 45,000/- (Approximately)
<b>Caution Money</b>	: Rs. 5000/- , Non-refundable; if selected and not participated.  <b><i>Demand Draft in the name of "Bharat Scouts &amp; Guides", payable at New Delhi</i></b>
<b>Last Date of Application</b>	: As the quota is limited, selection will be on the basis of " <b>FIRST COME FIRST SERVE</b> " The applications of the participating candidates should reach National Headquarters, New Delhi on or before <b>30<sup>th</sup> April 2016 along with photocopy of valid passport.</b>
