2	Dates (Duration)	:	From 04 th to 09 th September, 2016. (Six days)
3	Date of Arrival	:	04 th September, 2016 before 04 pm.
4	Date of Departure	:	09 th September, 2016.
5	Venue	:	Om Shanti Retreat Center, Gurgaon: Village Bahora Kalan, Pataudi Road Distt. Gurgaon • 2 km off NH-8 at Bilaspur Crossing • 45 km from IGI International Airport • 11 km from Pataudi Road Railway Station
6	How to Reach	:	BY BUS ORC is well connected by state roadways buses plying on Delhi – Rewari route. The buses can be boarded from Sarai Kale Khan bus terminus (adjacent to Hazarat Nizamuddin Railway Station) and Dhaula Kuan intersection in New Delhi (from where the Delhi Jaipur National Highway no. 8 starts). The participants shall have to take a ticket for Bilaspur Crossing, from where ORC is just 1.5 km. Further auto rickshaws or local buses can be boarded to reach ORC, who charge a bare minimal amount. Candidates travelling by state roadways bus to Delhi & descending at Kashmere Gate or Anand Vihar inter-state bus terminus can move to Sarai Kale Khan bus terminus or Dhaula Kuan, to board a state roadways bus to ORC. TRAIN & METRO facilities are also available. Kindly refer the attachment for details(page no 09)
7	Who can Participate	:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scouts / Guides /Rovers / Rangers/Unit Leader in the age group of 16 to 29 years can participate. • Participants of the camps should be within the prescribed age limit on 1st May 2016. • All the registrations must be filled online by the participating candidate at http://delhi.brahmakumaris.com • Registrations shall start after 20th May 2016. The co-ordinating office shall not accept hard copies in any form. • The entries would be accepted on first- cum-first serve basis.

09	What to Carry	:	Two sets of Correct & Complete Uniform as per APRO II/III, personal belongings, personal first aid kit and medicine if any, sleeping bag and mat, bed sheet, water bottle, torch, toilet requisites, Plate, Spoon, Glass & Mug etc. and materials for Competitions, Traditional Costumes for Cultural Programmes. They should carry all the required materials as per the programme. Traditional attires should be carried to perform Cultural programmes as per the DAY TO DAY Programme attached (page no. 8&9).
10	Financial Assistance	:	Travelling expenses reimbursement will be restricted and payment for the shortest way travelled by 2nd class sleeper (in Train) or ordinary bus (run by state roadways) or metro on submission of the proof (tickets for bus & train and travel card or receipt for metro) in original or Xerox (as per applicable).
