SUB.: 17TH NIPPON SCOUT JAMBOREE, JAPAN

Dear Sir/Madam,

We are glad to inform you that Scout Association of Japan is organizing the 17th Nippon Scout Jamboree to be held at the campsite of Refresh Village Hachigasaki, in Suzu, Ishikawa from Thursday, 4 to Monday, 10 August 2018.

About 600 overseas Scouts, Guides and Leaders in addition to 12,000 Scouts/Guides and Leaders throughout Japan to take part. A warm welcome and traditional hospitality will await the participants, and there will also be exciting and challenging activities such as water activities at the long coastline with spectacular seascapes in front of the Jamboree site. Much more enjoyable activities and experience will strengthen the ties and mutual friendship among overseas and Japanese participants.

Details as follows:

Name of Event	: 17 th Nippon Scout Jamboree, Japan
Dates	: 04 th to 10 th August, 2018 Arrival: Afternoon of Saturday, 4 August. Departure: Morning of Friday, 10 August.
Venue	: Refresh Village Hachigasaki in Suzu, Ishikawa, some 430 Km northeast of Osaka and some 620 Km northwest of Tokyo. Latitude: 37.4463 North, Longitude: 137.3265 East, Altitude: 5m on average. Refresh Village Hachigasaki is a resort complex in Suzu-city located at the tip of the Noto Peninsula facing the Japan Sea. It is about 5 km to the east from the center of Suzu-city.
Theme	: "ADVENTURE" – NOTO FOR FUTURE
Eligibility	: The Jamboree programmes are designed for both male and female Scouts and Guides aged 12-15, and Venture/Senior Scouts and Guides aged 15-18 may take part in as the Service Corps. Scouts/Guides aged 15 to 18 from other National Scout/Guide Organizations are welcome to challenge the Jamboree programmes with younger Japanese Scouts.
Jamboree Fee	: To be notified later (approx. JYE40,000 per person) i.e. (approx. INR – 25,000/-). The fee covers rations for 17 meals starting from dinner on August 4 and programs during the camp.

		Other expenses, like transportation from Narita International Airport or other ports of entry to the Jamboree site, and cost of touring Japan excepting for the home hospitality period, are responsibilities of your contingents.
Air-fare and Visa charges	:	New Delhi ⇌ Narita International Airport (Japan) – INR. 60,000/- (Approximately) (Including Visa Charges).
Equipment	:	Participants should bring personal camping equipment including sleeping bag, rain-wear, swimming trunks, eating kit and flash-light. Tents and cooking utensils will be provided for overseas participants.
Home Hospitality	:	Before or after the camp, overseas contingents will be offered home hospitality on request, for maximum of 3 days.
Caution Money	:	Rs. 5000/- , Non-refundable; if selected and not participated. <i>Demand Draft in the name of "Bharat Scouts & Guides", payable at New Delhi</i>
Last Date of Application	:	As the quota is limited, selection will be on the basis of "FIRST COME FIRST SERVE" The applications of the participating candidates should reach to National Headquarters, New Delhi on or before 15th December, 2017 along with photocopy of valid passport and caution money.

You are requested to encourage your Scouts, Guides and Leaders and send their applications in the prescribed Proforma (enclosed) to the National Headquarters, Bharat Scouts & Guides, New Delhi latest by **15th December, 2017**.
