Dates	: 16 <sup>th</sup> to 20 <sup>th</sup> September, 2017 (05 days)
Venue	: Base Camp – Aashirwad Complex, Karta, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board
Date of Arrival	: 16 <sup>th</sup> September, 2017 before lunch
Date of Departure	: 20 <sup>th</sup> September, 2017 after lunch
How to Reach	: Trains are available up to Karta (Shmata Vd Katra - SVDK). Ashirwad Complex, Karta, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board is a walkable distance of 1 km. from Katra Bus Stand and 2 km. from Railway Station. For further details please contact : - 1. Who can participate	: Warrant holder young unit leaders having sound health may be selected according to the quota allotted to the State. Each candidate has to submit Physical Fitness Certificate from the appropriate authority. Unfit candidate should not be selected.
Quota allocation	: <b>Scouters – 02</b> <b>Guiders – 02</b> <b>Total = 04</b>
Fee	: Rs. 200/- Development Fee & Rs. 80/- Special Fee, Total Rs. 280/- per head to be paid at the time of Registration.
What to Carry	: 2 Sets of Correct & Complete Uniform as per APRO Part-II / III, Track Suit, Sleeping Bag. Warm bedding, Ruck sack. Comfortable Sport/Trekking Shoe, Sleeping mat, Plate and Mug, Spoon, Writing Material, Note Book, First-Aid Kit, Lunch Box, P-Cap, Tracksuit, Jeans, Warm Clothing's, toilet requisites, Water-bottle, torch and other necessary material required for the Trekking camp.

<b>Financial Assistance</b>	: National Headquarters will reimburse second class (Sleeper) Concessional Train Fare and Actual Bus Fare (Ordinary/ Express Bus of State Transport authority only) on production of photocopy of Train Tickets and Bus Tickets in Original (No Taxi, Auto, AC/Volvo fare is admissible). Railway States should ensure utilization of Railway Pass. <b>NOTE: The Travelling Expenses for the participants will be reimbursed to the State Association on receipt of Grant-in-Aid from the Govt. of India. Please inform the deputed candidates accordingly. The participants may please be instructed to submit their bank details along with T.E. Bill.</b>
<b>Risk Certificate</b>	: Each candidate has to submit a Risk Certificate (Enclosed) attested by the District Commissioner. Application with Risk and Medical Certificate is to be handed over during Registration along with the deputation letter of the State. <b>NOTE: Without Medical Fitness Certificate, Risk Certificate and deputation letter of the State, participants will not be admitted in the Camp.</b>
<b>Last Date</b>	: The name list of the selected candidates should reach to the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters, New Delhi at <a href="mailto:info@bsgindia.org">info@bsgindia.org</a> with a copy to State Secretary, BSG, Jammu & Kashmir State at <a href="mailto:jkbharat Scouts@gmail.com">jkbharat Scouts@gmail.com</a> on or before <b>31<sup>st</sup> August, 2017</b> along with the details of arrival and departure itinerary of the Participating Contingent. If your State is not utilizing the allotted quota, please inform us at the earliest so that additional quota may be allotted to other States.

**NOTE:-** Since, Aashirwad Complex is allotted to Bharat Scouts and Guides from 16<sup>th</sup> (morning) to 20<sup>th</sup> September (afternoon), 2017. Participant arriving earlier or departing late shall have to arrange their own accommodation. Hence, it is advised that participants may please be instructed to report only on 16<sup>th</sup> September morning and leave the camp site on 20<sup>th</sup> September afternoon.
