Due to some unavoidable circumstances the National Level Standard Judging Camp which was proposed to be organize at NTC Pachmarhi will now be held at the Bharat Scouts & Guides, National Youth Complex (NYC), Gadpuri, Distt. Palwal, Haryana from 04th to 08th February 2018. Details of the camp are as follows:-

Venue	:	The Bharat Scouts & Guides, National Youth Complex (NYC), Gadpuri, Distt. Palwal, Haryana
Date of Reporting	:	04 th February 2018 before lunch
Date of Departure	:	08 th February 2018after lunch
How to Reach		Gadpuri is situated on Delhi Mathura Road in between Palwal and Ballabgarh. (Just 10 K.M. from Ballabgarh and Palwal). Local Trains are available from Delhi/New Delhi/Nizamuddin Railway Station for Ballabgarh&Palwal. Bus services are also available from Delhi (Sarai Kale Khan), Faridabad/Ballabgarh/Palwal for Gadpuri. Share Auto services are also available from Ballabgarh/Palwal for Gadpuri.
Who can attend	:	Rovers & Rangers completed Nipun Badge or above may only be deputed.
Fees		Development Fees Rs. 100/- for Rovers/ Rangers Rs. 200/- for Adult Leader and Special Fee Rs. 80/- for Rovers/ Rangers and Adult Leaders. Total Rs. 180/- for Rovers/ Rangers and Rs 280/-for Adult Leader.

Quota Allocation	:	Rover Scout- 06 Ranger - 06 + 01 Ranger Leader		
Financial Assistance	:	Total: - 13 (No additional participants will be accepted). 02 nd Sleeper Class Concessional Train fare and actual ordinary Bus fare by Govt./Private bus will be reimbursed by the National Headquarters on production of Train and bus ticket in original. Bus fare will be paid for the shortest route where there are no train services. Deluxe Volvo Buses or taxi/auto fare is not admissible. Tatkal Charges will not be paid. Participant from Railway States Should Travel by Railway Passes. Please Note: Travelling Expenses of participants will be reimbursed on receipt of Grant-in-Aid from the Govt. of India. The Escorting Unit Leader may be instructed to submit his/her Bank details to the Leader of the Event along with T.E.Bill.		
What to Bring	:	INDIVIDUAL KIT: Two sets of Correct and complete uniforms as per APRO- II/III, Toilet requisites, Personal dress, Warm Clothing (Sweater/ Jacket, Monkey Cap, Muffler as Gadpuri will be too cold), Knotting Rope, Sutli, Knife, Personal First Aid Kit, Plate, Glass, Spoon, Torch, Chart Paper, Writing Materials, Warm Bedding, Traditional Costumes for Cultural Programmes, required materials for Exhibition etc.		
		<u>PATROL KIT</u> : - Patrol utensils such as Patila, Parat, Bucket, Kettle, Mug, Plate, Spoon, Dari Gadget & Pioneering materials, Chart paper, Costumes for Cultural Programme, Colour Party dress & Flags, Patrol Flag and other materials related to all the competitions. No competition materials will be supplied from the campsite.		
Award of Standard		The Patrol will be Awarded "A" and "B" Standard if minimum 70% and 60% marks are secured respectively. Standard Certificates if achieved will be given on the last day of the camp. The following are the subjects for competition. 1.Camp Craft2. First Aid 3. Patrol Pioneering 4. Mapping 5. Campfire 6. Backwoodsman Cooking 7. Flag Ceremony 8. Fire Rescue 9. Drill & March Past 10. Colour Party. 11. Aerobics.		
DESCRIPTION OF SUBJECT Some Competition will be held separately for the Rovers/Rangers and some Joint competitions.				
1. Camp Craft	:	A team of 06Rovers/Rangers will participate. Following are the subjects to be adjudged i.e. Gadgets, Pits Uniform, Cleanliness in tent and surroundings, Layout, Display of utensils and other materials.		
2. First Aid	:	A team of 06 members will participate. The syllabus based on Ambulance man Badge both theoretical and practical will be judged.		

3. Patrol Pioneering	:	A team of 12 Rovers/Rangers will participate. Project will be announced by judge on the spot. Materials will be supplied to the team from the campsite.(Joint activity)
4. Mapping	:	A team of 06 members will participate. Study of Compass, finding the bearings, scale, and conventional signs, Grid Reference, Finding North, Map reading and Map marking will be judged.
5. Campfire		A team of 06Rovers/Rangers will participate in one team for duration of 5 minutes. Musical Instruments should be brought by the teams. Team work, Educational Values, Costumes and presentation will be judged.
6. Flag Ceremony	:	A team of 06 members will participate and perform the ceremony.
7. Backwoods Man Cooking	:	A team of 06 members will participate. The team will prepare suitable dishes for lunch for two persons only without using utensils within the stipulated time. Provision materials as per evaluation will be supplied from the Central Mess.
8. Fire Rescue	:	A team of 12 members will participate. (Joint activity)
9. Drill & March Pass	:	A team of 09-12 members will participate. (Joint activity)
10. Colour Party	ŀ	A team of 05 members will participate (Combined Competition)
11. Aerobics*	:	A team of minimum 06 members will participate (Joint activity)
