AGENDA ITEM NO.8: ANY OTHER MATTER WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR.

Smt. Geetha Nataraj, Headquarters Commissioner for Projects, Karnataka State Bharat Scouts & Guides pointed out that the paper quality of Rashtrapati Award Application Form is very thin and quality should be improved as the form is being moved in many hands to complete the formalities before forwarding to the National Headquarters. The National Commissioner directed the Director to put up the matter for consideration.

She also proposed that the Medium of Rashtrapati Scout/Guide Award Testing Camps should be in the Regional languages for the children of Rural Areas. The proposal was not found acceptable. She also pointed out that in ROT of Guide Wing; participants are made to write the anecdotes at night daily which is not in the syllabus. Miss M. N. Machamma, Asstt. Director (G), NTC, Pachmarhi informed that such decision is made by the LOC concerned and it is not compulsory as per the syllabus. National Commissioner directed that if the subject is not in the syllabus, it should not be included in future.

Shri B. P. Gupta, SOC(S), Arunachal Pradesh State Bharat Scouts & Guides proposed that the N. E. Regional Headquarters presently located at Azara which is in outskirt of the City may be shifted to the main City Guwahati to facilitate the Visitors as well as the participants participating in the Regional Events.

Smt. Sudesh Sharma, Former STC (G) of Northern Railway State Bharat Scouts & Guides pointed out that the ensuing Professional Management Course to be held from 01st to 05th October, 2013 at NTC, Pachmarhi is coinciding with the ROT Course. It was proposed that Professional Management Course be postponed and the new dates be announced. National Commissioner accepted the proposal and directed the Deputy Director(S), L.T. to do the needful.

Before concluding the meeting, National Commissioner informed the members about serious complaints received against the two Senior most Professional office bearers of the Association viz. Shri Rakesh Kumar Sharma, Officiating Director and Smt. Geeta Rawat, Joint Director(Guides). The complainant, Shri Ashok Kumar Mohapatra, ROC(S), Eastern Region, had alleged extortion of money from him by compelling him to commit

irregularities in Camps expenditures coupled with harassment and deliberate denial of opportunity to him to attend World Leadership Development Programme(W.L.D.P.) event in Metherlands despite his name having been approved by the National Commissioner and WAGGG sanctioning the funds for his participation. National Commissioner informed that necessary Charge Sheets are being issued against them in the matter and considered it appropriate to brief the members of the National Executive Committee since it involved the two Senior most Professionals in the Organisation. Some members opined that the equitable opportunity should be given to the officials to submit their explanation before taking a final decision which the National Commissioner
